AOGIN INDIA EDUCATION GRANT

Objectives:

To promote education and research in the field of genital infection and cancers and to facilitate the young clinicians/scientists to undertake training courses or present their study findings in appropriate forum.

Eligibility:

- Indian scientists/clinicians not above the age of 40 years on the date of application
- Should possess appropriate scientific or medical postgraduate qualifications
- Applicant should be AOGIN India member
- The applicant should seek support to either attend training course or fellowship relevant to the field of screening/detection technologies, colposcopy and management of genital neoplasias or present oral paper in national/international conference related to subjects mentioned earlier.
- Preference will be given to candidates seeking support to present oral paper/poster in AOGIN or AOGIN-India conferences
- A candidate who has been offered the grant once cannot reapply.

Amount of Grant:

Every calendar year two candidates will be offered the Education grants, each amounting to maximum Rs. 10,000 (all inclusive). The grant should be utilized to meet the expenses of the conference registration fees or course/fellowship fees, travel and stay during the conference or course/fellowship. No other claims for reimbursement will be entertained.

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Application for the Grant:

Applications for the grant will be received twice a year and will be closed as soon as two grants have been offered. The last date for receiving applications are 30 June and 31 December for first half and second half of the year respectively. The application form can be accessed via the link given below. The filled in form can be downloaded as a PDF. Which can be e-mailed to aogin.india09@gmail.com. All applications will be reviewed by a group of referees designated by the Chairperson of Education Committee, AOGIN India. The successful candidates will be informed about the sanction of the grant within one month of the last dates of application. The awardees will have to attend the training program/ conference/ workshop specified in the grant offer letter within the stipulated time mentioned in the letter. In case there is delay in attending the training/workshop, the member must give suitable justification, without which the offer will become null and void. The decision of the AOGIN India Education Committee will be final.

Method of Payment:

Payment will be made through A/C Payee cheque in the name of the successful candidate on submission of copy of attendance certificate along with original bills and vouchers. Payment will be made either to reimburse actual expenditure or Rs. 10,000 whichever is less.
